PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2010-2011

Another successful season completed for the Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association. We had 15 affiliated clubs, 232 teams and 2700 players. The teams range from Under 8s through to Under 17s. The Association raised the upper age limit from Under 16s to Under 17s. The feedback received from the Clubs regarding the introduction of Under 17s was most positive and was well received by the players.

This season we saw the new club The Lakes Cricket Club affiliate with BNJCA. Previously they had played under the banner of the Pine Rivers Junior Cricket Club. They started with 43 players – four teams (Under 8, Under 9, Under 10 and Under 12).

In an Association as large as ours with its many idiosyncrasies there are many people to thank who give of their time to coordinate all the events and ensure that everything throughout the season runs smoothly. Thank you to our Vice President, Mr Bruce Boland – a man of many roles - for the competition draw - a most difficult task that also has changes during the season due to the sudden unavailability of grounds at schools at various times. Bruce also took on the role of Under 16 State Championships Coordinator which was very much affected by wet weather. He is also our Webmaster.

To Mr Gary Somerville who had the role of coordinating the Under 14 Anstey/La Frantz competition, excellent work, well done, thanks Gary. Thank you to Platypus for their Cricket ball sponsorship and our major sponsor Keith Dudgeon of KD Sports for sponsoring the Premiership caps. Anstey La Frantz winners were the Tigers catchment coached by Craig Smith. Congratulations to you all. The Anstey/La Frantz is growing from strength to strength and the players coming through the age groups cannot wait to be involved in this competition.

To Mr John Powell who took on the role of the Under 15 Ray Weier Cup Coordinator, thank you. Using the Ray Weier Cup as a means to selection of our Under 15 Representative teams was very well received by all players and parents in this age group.

A huge congratulations to all the hard working affiliated Club Committees and their band of volunteers that give of their time to ensure all our young cricketers enjoy their chosen summer sport.

Our Club Champions were Wilston North with runners up Redcliffe City. Congratulations to both Clubs on the outstanding performances of their teams throughout the grades. Congratulations to the Premiership winners and all the Award winners.

We won 2 Queensland Junior Cricket 2010 Intra-State Age Championships with both our Under 12 Maroon team at Atherton coached by Cameron Wilson and our Under 13 team at Charters Towers going through the competition week undefeated. Also our Under 15 Development team coached by Brett Hutton won the Development Carnival in Bundaberg. What an outstanding effort from our young cricketers!

We had 2 rain affected Development Carnivals in January – our locally run Under 12 Healy Cup and the Under 14 Sunshine Coast Carnival. Both Carnivals were cancelled due to wet weather. We had many disappointed cricketers.

Once again we look forward to seeing you all back next season obviously with the exception of the older players for whom we wish the very best in their careers.

Vice President and Draw Committee report 2010-11

Over the past few seasons, nearly every available turf and synthetic ground has been in use in the pre-Christmas period for the u12-u16 age groups. Again this year at one stage we had no u16 oval spare and some games could not be played when turf wickets were unavailable.

This year we rostered the playing of U14 half season games to the afternoon as we had run out of suitable fields for morning use. This was implemented well by all clubs concerned and BNJCA is very appreciative of the co-operation shown by clubs and parents alike. The playing of half season games in the afternoon will continue to be monitored but Clubs can expect that some age groups will be playing in the afternoon in future seasons.

The response to the grounds questionnaire this year was not as accurate as possible and it resulted in some ovals being rostered for use which in fact turned out to be unplayable or at least unsuitable for the nominated age group. The playing condition of some ovals was a major cause of draw changes, causing more time and effort in oval moves and notifying teams of changes of venue. It is Imperative that Clubs understand the need for accuracy when completing the grounds questionnaire as the Draw is based on this information and it ensures that BNJCA resources are used to their full extent efficiently.

We unfortunately had a washout on our first playing Saturday when BNJCA reluctantly decided to cancel all games because of the condition of grounds across the zone. The next Saturday also had significant reductions in games due to rain. There were numerous Saturdays when we had no turf wickets available to use because of water and we also ran out of suitable synthetic wickets to use. On 4th December we again lost games due to the condition of ovals because of rain. On 7th January BNJCA had to cancel the U12 Ian Healy Cup carnival because of rain and the U16 State Championships at Brisbane Grammar grounds were virtually washed out with only 1 ½ days play over the week.

The first Saturday playing after the Christmas break and there were substantial numbers of ovals being reported as unplayable. After the floods the State Government issued a Public Health Advice regarding flooded ovals and player safety. On 5th March the BNJCA again cancelled all cricket games across the zone because of the widespread rain. We also lost the use of some ovals due to work on improvements to water retention systems adjacent to ovals during the season, asbestos removal at schools and construction work for school halls.

Valleys again played some Friday night games under lights at Yoku Road Ashgrove for u8 & u9 this season and have continued to have generally positive feedback, both from parents and clubs involved. It is expected that this initiative will be taken up by other clubs next season.

Thank you to the many state schools who allowed us to use their grounds during the season and I would also like to express our appreciation for their assistance in making the playing of junior cricket possible. Similarly, without support from the Warehouse Association, District Cricket clubs north of the river and a number of private schools, many of our activities would not have been possible.

Finally thanks to my fellow committee members for their support during the year.
