**STARTING TIMES:** Monday to Thursday; 9.00 a.m. Friday 8.30 a.m.

**VENUE: Main Centre:** Albany Creek Cricket Club, (South Pine Sports Complex)  
Cribb Road, Brendale. UBD 108 G12  
**Other grounds:** Albany Hills State School and Wantima Country Club

**RULES:** Normal Laws and ACB/QC Rules as modified by Special Development Rules attached.

**BEHAVIOUR:** ACB/QC and Australian Sports Commission as adopted by B.N.J.C.A.

**UMPIRES:** Official umpires will be provided by Queensland Cricket Umpires Association.

**PLAYER ELIGIBILITY:** Date of birth must not be before 1<sup>st</sup> September 1999. Players must not have played in U-12 Intra-state Championships for school or club based representative teams.

A list of team members and team officials is required before 31<sup>st</sup> December 2011. Mobile phone number of a team official is also required.

**STATISTICS:** Points Table and Players' Statistics will be produced daily and distributed to team officials.

**LUNCHES:** Lunch will be provided for twelve players, coach, scorer, manager and umpires and will be delivered to the ground. Lunch costs are included in the team levy.

**CANTEEN:** The Albany Creek Cricket Club will operate a canteen each day of competition at the South Pine Sports complex.

**WATER:** Each team to bring their own water containers that can be filled and refilled from on-site facilities.

**ICE/FIRST AID KITS:** Each team is to supply their own ice and first aid kits.

**CRICKET EQUIPMENT:** All teams are to provide their own playing gear with the exception of cricket balls, stumps, bails and boundary markers.

**SHADE:** It is recommended that each team bring their own shade e.g. tarpaulins for erection on the relevant oval.

**ON FIELD COACHING:** There shall be no coaching on the field except at drinks breaks. Coaches are entitled to send out messages in the normal way.

**COST:** Associations will receive a tax invoice for the team levy. This covers umpires fees, lunches, administration expenses, production of statistics, hire of grounds, provision of drinks and Sausage Sizzle for players, officials and supporters at the Closing Ceremony and accommodation and transport if applicable.

**TEAM LEVIES:**

**Teams with no transport or accommodation costs - \$1600 per team**

**Teams with accommodated at Marist College (5 nights)**

12 players plus two officials **\$5,950.00**

Additional players accommodated at **\$320.00** per person

**Teams with accommodation and transport to playing venues**

Team with two officials **\$7,330.00**

Team with three officials **\$7,650.00**

**Teams accommodated with transport provided from and return to the airport and daily to playing venues, \$7710.00**

**TEAM DUTIES:** For teams playing at Wantima Country Club and Albany Hills State School, the first named team in the draw is required to collect stumps, bails, boundary markers and scoreboard from the clubhouse at South Pine Sports Complex and take to the ground. The team named second is required to take the equipment together with score book pages of BOTH teams back to the clubhouse.

**AWARDS:** The Ian Healy Cup will be presented to the winning team
