BNJCA Annual Performance Award Guidelines

1. Introduction

Each year, the BNJCA presents performance awards to registered players who participated in its summer half season and full season junior competitions. The following guidelines create a framework for these awards.

2. Awards

The BNJCA Management Committee will decide on the categories of awards, in consultation with affiliated clubs. However, the philosophy of the Association is to limit categories, and in so doing, place a higher value on the awards. The primary categories for both half and full season players will always be:

- Highest Runs Aggregate
- Best Batting Average
- Most Wickets Taken
- Best Bowling Average.

3. Age groups/competitions

Awards will be presented in age groups from u11 to u16. There will be separate awards for half season and full season competitions.

4. Player eligibility

- a) Players must be registered with the BNJCA
- b) Players must have participated in at least 50% of scheduled games within their competition, either half or full season. Games which are forfeits or washouts are not counted for calculation of this participation eligibility.
- c) The BNJCA will set minimum eligibility criteria for batting average and bowling average awards, i.e., no. of innings and no. of overs.

5. Eligible performances

The only eligible performances are those which have been included on abstracts submitted by affiliated clubs at the conclusion of each scheduled BNJCA game. The only abstracts which will be considered are those submitted within the specified BNJCA deadline of 2 weeks from the conclusion of a scheduled game.

6. Confirmation of award winners

The Zone Recorder will provide the BNJCA Management Committee with a provisional list within one month of the conclusion of the summer full season. The BNJCA Secretary will provide the Secretaries of all BNJCA affiliated clubs with this provisional list to enable clubs to raise any issues (notwithstanding part 5 of these guidelines) with a response deadline of one month prior to the scheduled awards presentation.

All award winners will be notified by a letter from the BNJCA Secretary.
