RULES: Normal Laws and ACB/QC Rules as modified by Special Development Rules attached.
Shorter pitch length – 18metres.

DRAW: 3 Pools: A x 4 teams, B x 4 teams & C x 6 teams.

Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday

You will be allocated in one of 3 pools, A, B or C for rounds One, Two & Three on Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday.

- The team's final position in each original pool is determined by their total points score, including bonus points, after the first 3 days.

On Thursday

The teams will be reallocated into 3 new pools, according to the following criteria:

- The team with the highest points (including bonus points) in each pool plus the next highest ranked team decided by bonus points from across Pools A, B & C will be placed in the new Pool A. There are now 4 teams in Pool A for Thursday.
- The next 4 highest ranked teams, by points (including bonus points), across all Pools will be placed in the new Pool B. There are now 4 teams in Pool B.
- The next 6 ranked teams, by points (including bonus points), across all Pools will be placed in the new Pool C. There are now 6 teams in Pool C.
- Each new pool then plays a semi-final on Thursday, with each team playing against a team ranked by their total points in their first 3 games:
New Pool A - 1 V 4, 2 V 3
New Pool B - 5 V 8, 6 V 7
New Pool C - 9 V 14, 10 V 13, 11 V 12

The venues for Thursday's games will be advised to all teams by Steve Casey on Wednesday evening.

Friday

- Pool A - The two winners from the Pool A semis on Thursday play off for the Healy Cup to decide First and Second. The two losers on Thursday from Pool A play off for third and fourth.
- Pool B - Winners from Pool B semis on Thursday play off to decide 5th and 6th place overall. The two losers on Thursday play off to decide 7th and 8th place.

- Pool C – The two highest ranked teams (bonus points to decide as there will be three winners) from the games on Thursday, play for 9th and 10th. Next highest ranked teams play off for 11th and 12th place overall. The two lowest ranked teams would then play off to decide 13th and 14th place.

The Ian Healy Cup final will be played at Albany Creek Cricket Club. The venues for the other games on Friday will be advised to all teams by Steve Casey on Thursday evening.

All games on Friday will be **40** overs, to allow for transport back to Albany Creek Cricket Club for the presentation and BBQ.

POOL DRAW: As mentioned above we are having a Pool system this year due to the larger number of teams. BNJCA would prefer that those associations fielding two teams, grade their teams. The stronger team from each association than will be placed in either Pool A or Pool B with the weaker side playing in Pool C which has six teams. The Draw will be sent out closer to the carnival.

BEHAVIOUR: CA/QC and Australian Sports Commission as adopted by BNJCA.

UMPIRES: Official umpires will be provided by Queensland Cricket Umpires Association.

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY: Date of birth must not be before 1st September 2006. Players must not have played in U-12 QJC State Championships or for a School State representative team.

A list of team members, dates of birth, MyCricket ID and names of all team officials is required before 14th December 2018. Mobile phone number of a team official is also required.

STATISTICS: This year all teams are required to input their results into MyCricket each evening. Each team MUST have a person who can enter results into MyCricket. The daily results are extremely important in order to rank the teams for the Pools and for individual performance awards. Points Table and Players' Statistics will be produced daily and distributed to team officials.

LUNCHES: Lunch costs are included in the team levy and will be provided for twelve players, coach, manager, scorer (if included in team numbers) and umpires and will be delivered to the ground.

CANTEEN: The Albany Creek Cricket Club and Ferny Cricket club will operate a canteen each day of competition.

WATER: Each player is to provide their own water bottle. Each team to bring their own bulk water containers that can be filled and refilled from on-site facilities. Cricket Far North will be supplied with an esky type container and a water dispenser to reduce airline luggage concerns.

ICE/FIRST AID KITS: Each team is to supply their own ice and first aid kits.

CRICKET EQUIPMENT: All teams are to provide their own playing gear with the exception of cricket balls, stumps, bails and boundary markers.

CRICKET BALLS:

Supplied as part of the team levy: 5 x 142gm two piece cricket balls per team.

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SHADE: There are shade shelters on all the ovals however it is recommended that each team bring their own shade e.g. tarpaulins for erection on the relevant oval.

ON FIELD COACHING: There shall be no coaching on the field except at drinks breaks. Coaches are entitled to send out messages in the normal way.

COST: Associations will receive a tax invoice for the team levy. This covers umpires fees, lunches, administration expenses, hire of grounds, provision of drinks and Sausage Sizzle for players, officials and supporters at the Closing Ceremony and accommodation and transport if applicable.

TEAM LEVIES:

Teams with no transport or accommodation costs

14 people (12 players plus two officials)	incl GST \$2,420
15 people (12 players plus three officials)	incl GST \$2,485

Teams with accommodation PLUS daily transport to & from playing venues

14 people (12 players plus two officials)	incl GST \$9,900
15 people (12 players plus three officials)	incl GST \$10,400

Teams with accommodation PLUS daily transport to & from playing venues PLUS transport from and return to, the airport

14 people (12 players plus two officials)	incl GST \$10,300
15 people (12 players plus three officials)	incl GST \$10,900

TEAM DUTIES:

All of the stumps, boundary markers and scoreboards for teams playing at Albany Creek State School, Albany Hills State School and Alf Shaw Park will be stored in sheds at each of the ovals.

For teams playing at South Pine and Ferny Reserve the ovals will be setup with stumps, boundaries and scoreboards.

A team official is required to enter the daily results into **MyCricket** using their scorebook.

AWARDS:

- The Ian Healy Cup will be presented to the winning team on the day and a name plaque of the winning team will be attached to the perpetual Cup.
